Reciprocal arrangements exist with the Lichfield Science and Engineering Society whereby members may attend each other's meetings without charge.

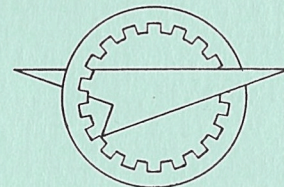
