# Treasurer's report

To date 39 members have renewed their membership of the Society, including 2 new members.

The membership of the Society was reviewed. It was noticed that a few members had not renewed their membership last term and it was agreed that their names would be removed from the list unless informed by the members concerned.

The 2022 membership subscriptions were reviewed. The Treasurer provided the committee with details of the costs in running the Society over the last 4 years. The membership number has been maintained during this period; consisting of now 40 paid members and other classifications that do not pay consisting of juniors, the President, I Mech E.

The annual income, at the present membership level, is £600 pa. Speakers' fees and expenses could be of the order of £300+ pa, College room hire of £96 per session. Expenses £200 pa. I MechE contribution to room hire of £200 pa. It is clear that at the present level of paid membership the Society is running at an annual loss. The Society accounts show a bank surplus which would be run down if the present subscription level is maintained.
